ABOUT THE INSTRUCTORS

Sara Harper is both a LTA (Living the Art) Instructor for the JSJ Faculty and a very experienced JSJ Practitioner. A reluctant teenager in the seventies, Sara came to JSJ

through her mother. Then years later after a traumatic car accident and a year of sessions, she finally understood the power behind the art. It was at this time that she was introduced to the Self Help Books and began practicing on herself. In 1984 she began studying with Mary Burmeister and has been a student ever since.

Terry Matthews has practiced Self Help Jin Shin Jyutsu since 1989. He was introduced to this engaging art of self study by an American JSJ practitioner living in the UK. Shortly after gaining practitioner status (1993), he began teaching Self Help classes in Adult education. Terry moved to Arizona in 2001. He now works at the International headquarters of Jin Shin Jyutsu in Scottsdale, where he is available for Jin Shin Jyutsu appointments and Self Help classes.

MENTORING PROGRAM
